Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership & clinical supervision to 22 School Social Workers (SSW) and Family School Liaison Workers (FSLW)
- Provide leadership and supervision to 4 Social Emotional Learning (SEL)
 Facilitators
- Provide ongoing guidance and consultation for the teams as well as Administrators in the School Division
 - Leadership in the development and delivery of all programming
 - Ensuring that clinical best practices are followed
 - Ensure high-quality record management through the electronic record system
 - Program development and evaluation
- Recruitment, onboarding, training, and mentoring new staff while ensuring their performance is compliant with policies, procedures and protocols
- Evaluating staff performance and identifying areas of strength as well as areas of improvement or concern
- Administrative duties such as setting schedules, approving timesheets and expense claims
 - Responsible for budget for staffing, program operation, expenditures
 - Responsible for applications, budget, and reporting
- Provide mental health consultation, support and advocacy for students and families

- Promote and facilitate team building
- Collaboration with service providers regarding mental health prevention, promotion and intervention
- Coordinate relevant training and support operationalization of supports including Suicide Risk Assessment and VTRA
- Collaborate and advocate with community resources and agencies to provide supports and programming for students, families and schools
- Provide crisis response; organize and deploy a crisis response team; debrief
- Act as the point person and referral source for specialized programs
- Provide leadership, consultation and support to the School Resource Officer team as well as program evaluation
- Ensures effective communication & follow up with the Assistant Superintendent on any relevant issues

Required Qualifications:

- Master's degree in clinical psychology or social work (with psycho-social intervention designation preferred)
- Current registration in good standing with professional college identified under the Health Professions Act
- Experience providing leadership and supervision to a large and diverse team
- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and collaborative problem solving and organizational skills
- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with stakeholders, families, students and team members
