Finalizing the 2024-2025 Strategic Plan

- The Board completed its contributions to the revised CASS strategic plan at the September Planning Meeting, with final adjustments reviewed in October.
- Based on feedback, further amendments were made to ensure relevant and achievable success indicators. •
- The updated strategic plan will be presented to the membership at the November AGM. .
- The 2024-2025 strategic plan focuses on strengthening leadership in Alberta's education system by deepening . member engagement, offering impactful professional learning, and strengthening advocacy on key issues like budget, curriculum, and teacher recruitment.
- CASS aims to create a collaborative environment that supports professional growth for system education • leaders.

2023-2024 Annual Report

- The annual report detailed a year of substantial progress in professional growth, collaboration, and strategic initiatives.
- Among the year's achievements was the implementation of CASS' Continuing Education Program, reinforcing its commitment to ongoing professional learning and alignment with Alberta's professional leadership standards.
- The report also highlighted how through conditional grant funding, CASS advanced initiatives addressing . workforce challenges and enhancing success for First Nations, Métis, and Inuit students.
- By building partnerships, promoting leadership excellence, and elevating member capacity, CASS continues to • strengthen its influence across Alberta's education landscape, marking significant strides toward equitable and effective learning environments for all students.

Summer Learning 2026 and Beyond Location/Venue

- The recent summer conference at the JW Marriott ICE District in Edmonton received high praise from delegates • for the venue's quality.
- Although contracts for the 2026 and 2027 conferences are currently not urgent, beginning negotiations at this . time would help secure availability and establish favourable contractual terms.
- The hotel's proposal includes an attractive cost-effective room rate, waived banquet room rentals, and the same rates from 2025 for 2026 and 2027.
- With the proposal held until November 30, 2024, the Board made a formal motion to proceed with a contract for • 2026 and 2027.

- The Board approved **"Professional Learning through Accreditation: Growing System Education Leadership** in Alberta" as the theme for the Spring issue, focusing on professional learning.

- This theme will also emphasize how CEP supports ongoing learning, aligns with current priorities, and highlights its impact on system education leadership across Alberta.

CASSA Board Member Opportunity

- At its May 2022 meeting, the Board made a formal motion to have the CASS 2nd VP serve on the CASSA board for a 2-year term, and upon conclusion of the second year of service, the incoming 2nd vice president would assume the next two-year term.
- This arrangement aligns with the goal of enhancing governance knowledge on national education topics impacting Alberta.
- Dr. Reagan Weeks has agreed to serve as a CASSA board member for a two-year term, 2024-2026, prior to her assuming the president position for CASS.
