This pivotal role will provide visionary leadership and strategic oversight for key areas impacting student achievement and educator growth across our division. The successful candidate will be a champion for equitable access to high-quality education, deeply committed to fostering a culture of continuous learning and cultural responsiveness.

The Division:

The Palliser School Division is a public-school jurisdiction located in southern Alberta. Palliser's geographical area stretches from Coaldale to Calgary, Alberta. In the 2025-2026 school year, the Division will have approximately 8 100 students. Palliser serves students in ECS through Grade 12 in 14 community schools; 9 faith-based alternative schools, 8 of which are in Calgary on 5 separate campuses; one sports-based alternative school; four alternative programs for Low German-speaking Mennonite families; 17 Hutterian colony schools; homeschooling, online and international programs.
