# **Board of Directors Meeting December 3, 2025**

#### **Meeting with Deputy Minister and Executive Team**

- The annual meeting with the Deputy Minister and Executive Team will take place during the in-person Board meeting on January 9, 2025, 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.
- The Board discussed potential topics and agreed that a draft agenda, including presenters and time allocations, will be reviewed by the Board the week of December 15 before being shared with the Deputy Minister.

#### Public Interest Disclosure (Whistleblower Protection) Act Timeline Update

- An update was provided on the Standing Committee's timelines.
- A final report is expected by June 27, 2026.
- CASS CEO will confirm whether CASS' recommendations have been accepted once information becomes available.

#### The Consortium (APLC) Reports and Financial Statements

- The Board received the Quarterly Report, Annual Report of Operations, and the 2024/25 Consolidated Financial Statement.
- The Board noted and appreciated the strong alignment with provincial priorities and the strengthened Assurance Framework.

## **CASS Conditional Grant Interim Report**

- The Board approved the interim report, which demonstrated significant progress across all five deliverables.
- The report highlighted high engagement in professional learning, strengthened supports for curriculum, literacy, nutrition, aggressive-behaviour response, Indigenous education, and career pathways.
- The report showed clear momentum and meaningful system impact.

## Career Education Conditional Grant Interim Report

- The Board approved the interim report, which demonstrated strong early progress.
- The report highlighted the province-wide needs assessment, new learning designers, and coordinated implementation plans that are already expanding high-quality professional learning opportunities in CTS and career pathways.

# Policy 21 – Research Endorsement Requests

The Board approved Policy 21, clarifying that CASS does not endorse external academic research but may engage in partnerships aligned with mandate, capacity, and privacy expectations.
