Board of Directors Meeting I May 6, 2026

Financial Report July 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026

- Conference expenses exceeded projections, but overall conference revenues have resulted in a positive financial margin.
- The Indigenous Education Gathering is expected to incur a loss due to venue costs but will be offset by the favourable financial outcome across the broader conference portfolio.

Superintendent of Schools Regulation Review

- CASS submitted a research-based report to the ministry for consideration.

Alberta Post-Secondary Network Engagement

- Engagement with the Alberta Post-Secondary Network (APSN) has been postponed to September.
- Potential discussion topics include the mandates, dual credit programming, expedited teacher certification pathways, and artificial intelligence in post-secondary education.
- The Board highlighted the need for greater consistency and coordination across post-secondary institution programming.

Strategic Planning & Teaching Profession Act

- CASS will undertake a jurisdictional scan and policy inquiry into leadership governance models across Canada using existing grant funding.
- The Board emphasized CASS’ role in providing research and guidance to support strong educational leadership practices.

Zone 6 Resolution – Colony Schools

- A letter advocating for continued printed PAT materials and marking supports was sent to the Deputy Minister.

June Board Meeting Planning

- The June Board meeting schedule will include strategic planning sessions and stakeholder engagement opportunities.
- Presentations from provincial and national partners are planned.

CASSA Presentation

- CASSA Executive Director Reg Klassen has been invited to present at the June Board meeting.
- The presentation will provide an overview of CASSA priorities and initiatives.
- The session is intended to strengthen alignment between CASSA and Board strategic priorities.
